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If a child is found to be eligible for Special Education as a Preschool Child with a Disability, the IEP Team will recommend an appropriate placement to meet the child's individual needs. Below is a summary of programs available within the Evesham Township School District:

Preschool Programs	
<p><u>In-district Integrated Preschool Program:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ~ Located at Rice School ~ Beginning at age 3 or 4 (by October 1st) ~ Students attend half-day sessions (am/pm), 4-5 days per week ~ 16 students per class (10 typical : 6 classified) ~ Play-based program where students learn together within a general education classroom setting ~ Taught by a certified teacher with two classroom aides ~ Curriculum: Creative Curriculum ~ Related services provided as determined necessary through evaluations and IEP 	<p><u>In-district Preschool Disabled Program:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ~ Located at Rice School ~ Beginning at age 3 ~ Students attend half-day sessions (am/pm), 4-5 days per week ~ Max: 12 classified students per class ~ Play-based program within a special education classroom setting ~ Taught by a special education teacher with two classroom aides ~ Curriculum: Creative Curriculum ~ Related services provided as determined necessary through evaluations and IEP
<p><u>In-district Preschool Autism Program:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ~ Located at Rice School ~ For students with a diagnosis of autism and in need of such a program ~ Students attend 4 full days per week, plus 2 half days per month ~ Instructional methods based on Principles of Applied Behavior Analysis including Verbal Behavior and task analysis. ~ As deemed appropriate by the IEP Team, students may be integrated into the Rice PSD program; home services may also be included as deemed appropriate ~ Creative Curriculum (modified implementation) and VBMAPP (Milestones Assessment Placement Program) ~ Related services provided as determined necessary through evaluations and IEP 	<p><u>Out-of-district Programs:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ~ An out-of-district placement may be recommended for students whose needs may not be met in the IPP or district program ~ Students may attend half-day or full-day depending upon the school and/or student's needs ~ Related services provided as determined necessary through evaluations and IEP
